RESOLUTION TO PURCHASE *WILMINGTON, NORTH CAROLINA METROPOLITAN AREA BICYCLE MAP* HOLDERS FOR ALL WAVE TRANSIT BUSES

WHEREAS, the Wilmington Metropolitan Bicycle and Pedestrian Committee currently has \$1,916.22 in funds,

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Transportation Division of Bicycle and Pedestrian Transportation recently funded the production of 5,000 *Wilmington, North Carolina Metropolitan Area Bicycle Maps*, and

WHEREAS, the Wilmington Metropolitan Bicycle and Pedestrian Committee has identified the need to educate and encourage non-competitive and non-recreational cyclists in the Wilmington area, and

WHEREAS, all WAVE Transit buses are equipped with bicycle racks and present a great opportunity to reach these cyclists.

THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Wilmington Metropolitan Bicycle and Pedestrian Committee shall purchase bicycle map holders for the interior of all WAVE Transit buses. These holders shall be installed and stocked by WAVE Transit staff.
