1. Call to order

A. Harrington called meeting to order at 3:04pm.

2. Approval of Minutes from June 23, 2016

S. Whitney made request to change "Glen Meade Rd to Savannah Ct" to "Savannah Ct to Graymont Dr" and to specify that the project added on Gillette Dr was added as a low priority project. T. Campbell made motion to approve the minutes for June 23, 2016 with changes presented, motion seconded by M. Hogan and it carried unanimously.

3. New Business

- Section 5: The committee discussed projects 160, 161, and 162 which are near a new
 elementary school that will open in the fall and a housing development that is currently
 underway. Projects 160 and 161 were moved to a high priority and project 303 was
 moved to medium priority due to these new developments. The committee discussed
 project 227 which is also on the New Hanover County Greenway Plan and decided to
 move it to a medium priority to promote short trail connections.
- Resolution supporting WMPO BikePed Committee Bylaws Revisions: B. Doliboa summarized the changes to the current bylaws; the new laws designate the Transportation Demand Manager (TDM) coordinator as voting member of the committee and members are now required to attend 51% of Bike/Ped committee meetings to remain as a voting member. B. Paris requested to change "The Chair of the Committee or, in his absence" to "The Chair of the Committee or in his/her absence". S. Whitney made motion to approve the revisions to the bylaws with changes presented, motion seconded by T. Campbell and it carried unanimously.

4. Discussion

- UNCW Bike Share Program: A. Harrington discussed UNCW's plans to implement a Bike Share Program and let the committee know the options for expanding that program throughout the region.
- Watch for ME NC: A. Harrington updated the committee on this year's Watch for ME NC campaign, discussing outreach, education and law enforcement involvement. All of the bike maps have been distributed through this campaign, there is no need for the Bike/Ped committee members to distribute bike maps this year.

5. Announcements


- A. Harrington informed the committee that she got the approval to do a digital commuter challenge in the fall and ask for the committee's support in promoting this challenge in the upcoming months.
- A. Schroetel discussed the NC Bike Summit that is taking place next month and BikeWalk NC's interested in holding the 2017 NC Bike Summit in Wilmington. Dear Mr. Kozlosky,

The purpose of this letter is to restate the position of the North Carolina State Ports Authority in relation to designated bicycle lanes on South Front Street (US 421 Truck). It is our understanding that South Front Street (US 421 Truck), a designated truck route through the City of Wilmington, is also designated as North Carolina Bicycling Highways 3 and 5.

In June of 2016, more than 16,000 trucks (more than 11,000 container trucks) moved through the Port of Wilmington, nearly all of the trucks utilize South Front Street (US 421 Truck) for highway access to the Memorial Bridge. The Authority has made significant investment in its infrastructure to accommodate a doubling of growth over the next five years. By 2020, the Authority expects to more than double its container and General Terminal commodities, most of this growth will be truck served.

South Front Street (US 421 Truck) is designated as the port truck route and routes traffic through a heavily industrialized area with active rail tracks. Another major industrial user on this stretch of road is Colonial Terminals with active trucking and rail operations. As you know, we are working with NCDOT and the WMPO to expand South Front Street (US 421 Truck) to four lanes to better accommodate the growing truck traffic and alleviate port congestion.

We are concerned that combining commercial traffic, that is expected to be growing extensively, with bicycle and pedestrian use on this truck route could present a dangerous situation and increase the probability of injury. Please note that a letter was sent from the Authority to your attention dated December 18, 2009 voicing a similar concern.

While the Authority supports the North Carolina Department of Transportation's policy of complete streets, defined as North Carolina's approach to interdependent, multi-modal transportation networks that safely accommodate access and travel for all users, it is our position that designation of South Front Street (US 421 Truck) as a bicycle route does not fit this description. I would like to work with the City and other community stakeholders to designate another local route for pedestrian and bicycle use in the region.

FUNDED PROJECTS IN PRELIMINARY DESIGN

U-5534A - TOWN OF NAVASSA – MAIN STREET BICYCLE LANES

This project will include planning, design, and construction of an additional 4 feet on either side of Main Street for bike lanes starting at the existing Navassa bike path east of Brooklyn Street to Old Mill Road.

Next Steps:

- The Town has indicated an interest in requesting the Board remove this project from the STIP. Staff is awaiting a letter from the Town.
- A meeting is scheduled between the Town, MPO and NCDOT to discuss the cost of the Navassa Park MUP project on September 9th

PROJECTS IN DESIGN

U-5534D - TOWN OF LELAND - OLD FAYETTEVILLE ROAD MUP

This project is for design and construction of a ten foot (10') wide multi use path, separate but adjacent to Old Fayetteville Road, beginning at or around the corner of the Leland Town Hall Campus and ending at the driveway of the North Brunswick High School.

Next Steps:

- Currently working on redesign and updating the PCE
- 90% plans submitted to NCDOT for review
- A meeting was held with Town, NCDOT, and WMPO on July 26th to discuss project. Significant
 design issues may exist. The Town is gauging property owner feelings towards right-of-way
 acquisition on the project.
- Updated schedule due September 9th

U-5534C - WRIGHTSVILLE AVENUE/GREENVILLE AVENUE TO HINTON AVENUE

The project is for construction of intersection re-alignment improvements at the intersection of Wrightsville Avenue/Greenville Avenue and bike lanes and sidewalks along Greenville Avenue from Wrightsville Avenue to Hinton Avenue.

Next Steps:

- Design plans are complete
- Right of Way underway
- Letting anticipated Spring 2017

U-5534E - TOWN OF CAROLINA BEACH - ISLAND GREENWAY AND HARPER AVENUE

This project is for the design and construction of an off-road multi-use path that begins at Mike Chappell Park and winds along the existing cleared fire path and terminates at Greenville Avenue and the Harper Avenue bike lanes will consist of a bicycle boulevard on existing pavement on each side of Harper Avenue from Dow Road to Lake Park Boulevard. The Town desires to combine the project with the awarded 2014 STP-DA project.

Next Steps:

- NCDOT Approval received
- Town if awaiting finalized plans and specifications
- Awaiting easement approval from MOTSU
- MOTSU completion date anticipated around September 30, 2016

U-5534H - HINTON AVE MULTI-USE PATH

This project consists of the construction of a 10' wide multi-use path along Hinton Avenue from Park Avenue to Greenville Avenue.

Next Steps:

- Plan comments have been addressed and plans and specs will be resubmitted by 8/15/2016.
- Utility coordination underway
- Anticipated Right-of-way Authorization October 2016
- Anticipated completion of right-of-way acquisition March 2017
- Anticipated Let Date of July 2017

U-5534G -HOOKER ROAD MULTI-USE PATH

The project consist of the construction of a 10' wide multi-use path along Hooker Road from Wrightsville Avenue to Mallard Drive/Rose Ave intersect

Next Steps:

- Plan comments have been addressed and plans and specs will be resubmitted by 8/15/2016.
- Utility coordination underway
- Anticipated Right-of-way Authorization October 2016
- Anticipated completion of right-of-way acquisition March 2017
- Anticipated Let Date of July 2017

U-5534K -LELAND MIDDLE SCHOOL SIDEWALK

The construction of 5 foot wide concrete sidewalk adjacent to Old Fayetteville Road from Ricefield Branch Rd to the Hwy 74/76 overpass after Glendale Drive with connections to Leland Middle School and the surrounding neighborhoods.

Next Steps:

- 100% Construction Plans completed
- The bid documents are being completed
- Awaiting the release of right of way funds
- The project is currently under review
- Anticipated Let Date: Spring 2017

U-5534J -OLD FAYETTEVILLE LOOP ROAD PEDESTRIAN LOOP

The construction of 5 foot wide sidewalks in three locations: along Village Road from Town Hall Drive going southeast to the existing sidewalk in front of the apartment complex, along Town Hall Drive from Village Road NE to the sidewalk currently under construction by the new Town Hall, and along Old Fayetteville Road from the existing sidewalk in front of the apartment complex to Village Road NE

Next Steps:

- 100% Construction Plans completed
- The bid documents are being completed
- Awaiting the release of right of way funds
- The project is currently under review
- Anticipated Let Date: Spring 2017

U-5534I -VILLAGE ROAD MULTI-USE PATH EXTENSION

The construction of a 10 foot wide asphalt multi-use path routed across Perry Ave, behind the library, out to Village Road, down Village Road ending on the western edge of the First Baptist Church property before the Sturgeon Creek Bridge

U-5527B CITY OF WILMINGTON - 5TH AVE INTERSECTION UPGRADES

This project is for the construction of high visibility crosswalks, curb ramps, and pedestrian activated signals on 5th Ave at the Dawson Street and Wooster Street intersections.

- Signal plans to be sent to NCDOT for review
- Quantities and specs are complete
- Right-of-way certification has been obtained

CITY OF WILMINGTON - MILITARY CUTOFF ROAD MULTI-USE PATH

This project is for the design and construction of a 10-foot wide, asphalt multi-use path on Military Cutoff Road from Drysdale Drive to Eastwood Road.

Next Steps:

- McKim & Creed provided surveying
- Man-day estimate from Stewart has been reviewed by NCDOT
- City is negotiating contract with Stewart
- R/W plans anticipated December 2016

SHIPYARD BOULEVARD SIDEWALK

Project Description: The construction of a sidewalk and bus pull-out along Shipyard Boulevard between Vance Street and Rutledge Drive. This will be a partnership between the City of Wilmington, Cape Fear Public Transportation Authority and Wilmington MPO.

U-55340 CAPE FEAR BLVD MULTI-USE PATH
