E-bike legislation in North Carolina

NC General Statutes

North Carolina General Statutes (NCGS) defines Electric Assisted Bicycles as bicycles with fully operable pedals and an electric motor of no more than 750 watts, capable of a maximum speed of 20 mph.

Electric assisted bicycles are not counted as motor vehicles (defined in § 20-4.01(23), which means according to § 20-160 they are allowed on sidewalks unless specifically provided otherwise.

The NCGS do not outline subclasses for types of e-bikes, although other states have done so in their laws, including Virginia, Tennessee, and Georgia.

Ordinances

Many cities in North Carolina do not specifically mention e-bikes in their ordinances. Examples from across NC:

🚲 **Kure Beach** defines electric bicycles as mopeds. Bicycles are prohibited from sidewalks and walkways.

🚲 **Carolina Beach** counts motorized bicycles as bicycles and specifies: "No person shall operate a bicycle at a speed greater than is reasonable and prudent under the conditions then existing." Bicycles are generally not allowed on sidewalks.

🚲 **Wrightsville Beach** specifies the same speed rules, and excludes bicyclists from all sidewalks and walkways.

🚲 **In Wilmington**, bicyclists may use shared-use paths provided that they yield to pedestrians.

🚲 **Belville** excludes e-bikes from their definition of motorcycles.

Other jurisdictions within the WMPO boundary were not found to specify rules or definitions for bicycling in their codes of ordinances.

🚲 **In Raleigh**, e-bikes may ride in

the same places as traditional bikes, adhering to speed limit rules (such as 10 mph for greenways). Motorized vehicles are prohibited. [Source](#).

🚲 **In Durham**, e-bike and motorized scooter users may use shared-use paths provided that they yield to pedestrians. [Source](#).

🚲 **In Charlotte**, e-bikes at a speed of less than 15 mph may ride on sidewalks, except in a specific downtown area. [Source](#).

E-bike Classes

In 2019, the WMPO created a model ordinance including these classifications:

🚲 **"Class 1"** - An electric bicycle with a motor that assists when pedaling only, until a maximum speed of 20 mph.

*This aligns with NCGS's definition of an "electric assisted bicycle" - § 20-4.01(7a).

🚲 **"Class 2"** - The motor on the e-bike may be used to propel the bicycle without pedaling, until a maximum speed of 20 mph.

*This aligns with NCGS's definition of a "motor-driven bicycle" - § 20-4.01(27i).

🚲 **"Class 3"** - The motor assists when pedaling only, until a maximum speed of 28 mph.

The model ordinance also outlined access rules, stating that Class 3 electric bicycles may be ridden on streets, roadways, and bike lanes, but are restricted from slower-speed off-road facilities (whereas Class 1 and 2 are permitted on multiuse paths, sidewalks, or designated park trails.)

Helmets are required for all riders.
