**RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2026-2035 STATE/WILMINGTON URBAN AREA
METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION TRANSPORTATION
IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMS**

WHEREAS, the Wilmington Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization provides transportation planning services for the City of Wilmington, Town of Carolina Beach, Town of Kure Beach, Town of Wrightsville Beach, Town of Belville, Town of Leland, Town of Navassa, New Hanover County, Brunswick County, Pender County, Cape Fear Public Transportation Authority, and the North Carolina Board of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the Board has found that the Wilmington Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization is conducting transportation planning in a continuous, cooperative, and comprehensive manner; and

WHEREAS, the final Draft 2024-2033 State/Wilmington Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization Transportation Improvement Programs were released in June 2025; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Board of Transportation adopted the 2026-2035 State Transportation Improvement Program on July 9, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Wilmington Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization conducted a 30-day public comment period and public hearing on the Draft 2026-2035 State/Wilmington Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization Transportation Improvement Programs; and


